

Skills Needed to Successfully Complete Second Grade

Learners will:

- Know multiplication facts to five including solving and creating word problems. (Ex.1. Jose bought pencils from the school store. He put them in five sets of four. How many pencils did Jose buy?)
- Read and write cursive writing. (see attached example)
- Write one paragraph with supporting details. (See attached example.)
- Identify, write and spell number words to nine hundred ninety-nine. Identify expanded notation and number sense to 999.

Ex.1. $136 =$ one hundred thirty-six, $867 =$ eight hundred sixty-seven.

Ex.2. $764 = 700 + 60 + 4$

EX.3. *What is the value of the underlined number: $7\underline{6}4 = 6$ tens or 60.*

Ex.4. *What number comes before 764? What number comes after 764?)*

- Read, spell and identify Fry words up to 250 by sight. (See attached List.)
- Demonstrate reading growth at an adequate rate.
- Know addition and subtraction facts through 20 including solving and creating word problems and identifying addition and subtraction key words. (Ex. 1. Sara collected shells during the summer. She found seventeen shells on her first trip to the beach. When she went back to the beach she found fourteen more shells. How many shells did she collect in all? 17 shells
 $+14$ shells
- Ex.2. There were twenty-six bats roosting in a tree, eight of them flew away to hunt for food. How many bats were there left roosting?
 26 bats
 $- 8$ bats
- Read and answer comprehension questions about grade level books. (See attached FCAT task cards for examples.)
- Summarize and sequence story events both orally and in written form using key words like first, next, then, and last.
