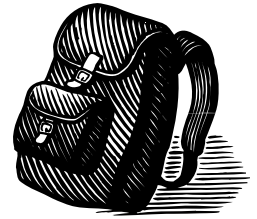


# First Grade Supply List

## School Year 2009-10



1. Each student should have a book-bag that can hang on the back of their chair comfortably. (No rolling or oversize book-bags, please!)

2. In the student's book-bag please send —

5 composition notebooks

5 **plastic** folders with **pockets and prongs** in the following colors – blue, green, purple, red, and yellow

1 **labeled** zippered pencil case containing:

4 sharpened pencils

1 blue pen

1 yellow highlighter

1 pack of crayons (**No more than 24, please!**)

1 pair blunt tip scissors

1 pencil sharpener with enclosure for shavings

(**No pencil boxes** because they will not fit in student's desks.)

3. In a separate bag please send (**label the bag but not the items**)

24 **sharpened** pencils (Dixon Ticonderoga, Berol, or Eberhard Faber)

1 bag pencil top erasers

2 blue pens (Paper Mate, Bic, Pilot, or Pentel)

1 box of 16-24 count crayons (**No more than 24, please!**)

12 glue sticks (Office Max, Office Depot, Staples, Elmer's or Avery)

1 pack of wide-lined notebook paper

1 ream of white copy paper

1 box of plain band-aids

1 box gallon size bags (like Ziplock, Glad, or a store brand)

1 box quart size bags (like Ziplock, Glad, or a store brand)

1 tissue box (like Kleenex or Puffs)

2 bottles of liquid hand soap

1 bottle of hand sanitizer gel

2 boxes of baby wipes (Not in tube containers, please.)

We've listed specific brand names because we've found that many of the generic brands are of an inferior quality and are just not of any use to the students. If you have a problem finding any of the items on this list please consult your child's teacher.
